



Logan Place Housing Support Staff (3rd Shift) Part-Time

Preble Street has a part-time Housing Support Staff opening at Logan Place. A Housing First residential program open 365 days a year, Logan Place is designed to meet the needs of 30 men and women who have experienced chronic homelessness. The Housing Support Staff will be responsible for providing program coverage, maintaining tenant safety, monitoring the security of the building, providing crisis intervention and support, and assisting tenants in overcoming barriers to stable housing. This Housing Support Staff position will work primarily at Logan Place, though may work across all residential programs.

The regular pay for this opportunity is \$15.85/ hr, however during this critical time, Preble Street is paying time and a half for all hours worked in shelter, food, and coverage programming, plus a \$2 differential for 3rd shift hours.

The schedule for this position is an overnight (awake) position for 2 nights (Wednesday and Thursday), from 12am-8am.

Job Requirements

- A bachelor's degree or an equivalent combination of education and experience in a helping profession.
- Candidates for this position must have a positive regard for individuals accessing services for homelessness and poverty
- Strong communication skills.
- Familiarity with community services and an understanding of low-barrier service challenges a plus.
- Qualified candidates will have ability to establish boundaries and set limits with a diverse population and the ability to work as part of a team.
- Residential services experience is preferred.
