



Logan Place Temporary Caseworker

Temporary, Full-Time

Preble Street has a **Temporary 1st shift Caseworker** opening at Logan Place, a Housing First residential program open 365 days a year, designed to meet the needs of 30 men and women who have been chronically homeless. This Caseworker will work primarily at Logan Place, though may work across all residential programs (if desired).

The regular pay for this opportunity is \$15.85/hr, however during this critical time, Preble Street is paying time and a half for all hours worked in shelter, food, and coverage programming.

The primary role of this position is to build relationships with tenants, provide caseworker services, provide program coverage, maintain tenant safety, monitor the security of the building, provide crisis intervention and support, and assist tenants in overcoming barriers to stable housing.

In addition, the Caseworkers are responsible for connecting tenants to needed resources, documenting the casework services provided, develop and implement groups and other programming and coordinating services and support across all Logan Place shifts.

The schedule for this position is Tuesday - Friday 8am - 4:30pm and Saturday 8am - 4pm

Job Requirements

- A bachelor's degree or equivalent experience in a helping profession is required.
- Candidates must have a positive regard for individuals accessing services for homelessness and poverty.
- An understanding of low-barrier service challenges.
- Strong communication skills and the ability to work as part of a team.
- Familiarity with community services.
- The ability to establish boundaries and set limits with a diverse population
- Residential services experience is preferred.
