



## Lewiston Wellness Shelter Overnight Staff –Temp. at \$23.78 per Hour

Part-Time, Temporary

All hands-on deck! An emergency 24-hour wellness shelter in Lewiston, ME has been established as a cross collaborative effort between the State of Maine and community providers to support individuals experiencing homelessness during this pandemic and **WE NEED YOU!** You will be building relationships and trust with guests, monitoring and assessing safety, and performing general housekeeping tasks under the direction of the shelter leadership. Additional opportunities to work in Preble Streets other shelter coverage programs available as well.

**The regular pay for this opportunity is \$15.85/hr, however during this critical time, Preble Street is paying time and a half for all hours worked in shelter, food, and coverage programming. Overnight shifts are awake shifts with an additional \$2 differential.**

### Job Requirements

- Understanding and positive regard for individuals experiencing homelessness.
- Understanding of low-barrier services and related challenges.
- Commitment to cultural sensitivity and ability to work effectively with diverse populations.
- Understanding of mental illness, substance use and co-occurring disorders.
- Ability to establish and always maintain professional boundaries in relationships and interactions with clients.
- Ability to work as part of a team and according to program and agency policies, practices and procedures.
- Ability and willingness to perform tasks as directed/requested to meet program and client needs.
- Skills in effective, respectful and professional communications with clients, team members and other service providers.
- Effective crisis intervention skills, with the ability to exercise sound judgement in challenging situations.
- Ability to consistently work shifts as scheduled and to remain awake for the duration of shifts.
